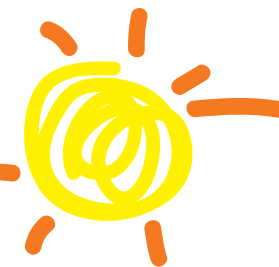
Medieval Mission
